From the Pen of the Pastor



I've missed you! I'm glad to be back in the USA and—more importantly--glad to be back at EBC. I was on a mission trip to Georgetown, Guyana, where I worshipped with and preached to the St. Paul and St. Mark's Presbyterian Churches, as a part of the Lott Carey Pastoral Excellence Program. I found Pastor Jameson, my host pastor, and the members of these two churches to be representative of the warmth, strength, and hospitality which characterize Guyana. Prior to this mission trip, my single recollection of Guyana was associated with the Jonestown tragedy of November 18, 1978, when a con-man named Jim Jones, masquerading as a visionary spiritual leader, coaxed 918 Americans-- many of whom were of color and working class--to participate in what he called "revolutionary suicide". Now, however, my new image of Guyana is a positive one, evolving out of my interaction with Guyanese Christians, who are possessed of an earthy spirituality and a healthy ecumenicity.

I understand, while I was away, some of you decided to play hooky. However, my sources inform me, that unless you streamed last weekend, you did more than forego worship. You, in fact, forfeited your blessing! After all, you missed Jocelyn Mann and the Youth who, with great creativity and competence, presented Christ at all four services. You, also, missed sampling the dynamic sermons of Rev. Douglass Banks and Rev. William Lee, who preached the Connection Remix and Sunday, respectively.

Although I missed last weekend, I won't miss this Connection Remix. I'm happy to be home to welcome, via baptism and right hand of fellowship, several new brothers and sisters into the EBC- Christian family. Equally important, I'm happy to host (at the Connection Remix) **Elder Jason Nelson, my brother, and the Greater Bethlehem Temple Church of Baltimore, MD.** I'm look forward to the fellowship!

In the meantime, let's continue to reflect on, pray about, and work towards the fulfillment of the EBC Playbook (Vision 2009). Let's remember, even though our Playbook may seem impossible and improbable, God "... is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine...." (NIV, Eph. 3:20) [Peace!](#)
